

Fun periodic table facts

- There are only 90 elements on the periodic table that occur in nature. All
 of the other elements are strictly man-made.
- Although you might expect atoms of an element to get larger as
 their atomic number increases, this does not always occur because the
 size of an atom is determined by the diameter of its electron shell. In fact,
 element atoms usually decrease in size as you move from left to right
 across a row or period.
- The present periodic table has room for 118 elements. Elements aren't discovered or created in order of atomic number. Scientists are working on creating and verifying element 120, which will change the appearance of the table.







